STEP 1-REACTION: GET _____

STEP 2-REFLECTION: THINK BEFORE YOU _____

"I pondered them in my mind..." (vs. 7a)

"So after thinking about it, I spoke out against these rich government officials..." Nehemiah 5:7 (LB)

STEP 3-REBUKE: _____ CONFRONT THE OFFENDING PARTY

"I then accused the nobles and officials. I told them, You are exacting usury from your own countrymen!" (vs. 7b)
