PRINCIPLES OF SUCCESSFUL ORGANIZING

1. SIMPLIFICATION: KEEP IT \_\_\_\_\_
AND FLEXIBLE

Eliashib the high priest and his fellow priests went to work
and rebuilt the Sheep Gate. They dedicated it and set its
doors in place, building as far as the Tower of the Hundred,
which they dedicated, and as far as the Tower of Hananel.
The men of Jericho built the adjoining section, and Zakkur
son of Imri built next to them. The Fish Gate was rebuilt by
the sons of Hassenah. They laid its beams and put its doors

Key Phrase: *"By his own house..."* (vs. 10, 23, 28, 29, 30)

**5. COOPERATION: ENCOURAGE \_\_\_\_\_**

Key Phrase: *"Next to him/them"* – 20 times

*"Two can accomplish more than twice as much as one, for the results can be much better. If one falls, the other pulls him up; but if a man falls when he's alone, he's in trouble."* **Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 (LB)**

**6. ADMINISTRATION: \_\_\_\_\_ THE WORK**
