1 "unequally yoked together" (Greek heterozygountes): from the Greek compound word heterozygéō. Heteros: another of a different kind. Zugos: a yoke or joining two to a single plow. This word is not found elsewhere in scripture. It is perhaps a term coined by Paul to express hisspecific sentiment.

"You must not plow with an ox and a donkey harnessed together." **Deuteronomy 22:10 (NLT)**

² "unbelievers" (Greek apistois): unbelieving, not faithful, unpersuaded, not convinced.

Apistois appears 23 times in the New Testament. Used primarily for those who refuse belief in thegospel (1 Corinthians 6:6, 1 Corinthians 7:12-15, 1 Corinthians 10:27, 1 Corinthians 14:22, 1 Timothy 5:8)

- and the resurrection (Thomas John 20:27).
- ³ "fellowship" (Greek metochē): partnership, participation.
- **4** "communion" (Greek koinonia): spiritual fellowship, communion, sharing in, partnership.
